CCI’s announces its new program “Day – Hab Activities,” a service program for individuals with disabilities. An open house is planned for Tuesday, April 28th, from 4 – 6 PM at 108 E Industrial St, DeWitt, IA.

Day – Hab Activities at CCI will assist or support individuals in developing or maintaining life skills and community integration. The structured setting will provide a relaxed environment for individuals who would like to acquire, retain or improve their leisure skills and their life-skills such as cooking, cleaning, socialization, community safety, etc. It is important that Day – Hab Activities stress community integration, which is designed to help individuals optimize their personal and social skills, so they can live successfully in the community.

The program will also be for individuals who don't have the stamina to work a full day. Day - Hab Activities allows these individuals to continue to have a structured full day, while working on both life skills and employment goals.

The Day – Hab Activities structure will include learning to prepare a meal, prepare a grocery list, shop and return to Day - Hab to cook the meal. Individuals will attend safety presentations, fire safety and stranger-danger presentations by area professionals. Additionally, individuals will

learn personal hygiene, self-advocacy, wellness, and communication skills and through games they will learn socialization skills to include getting along with others and taking turns.
